How to get there by car

THORPE PARK is just 20 miles from central London and easy to get to by car. From the M25, exit at Junction 11 or 13* and join the A320, which will take you to the Park. If you're setting your Sat-Nav, the postcode, once again, is KT16 8PN.

Car parking

There is loads of car parking for a small charge of £2 per car.

Coach parking

From the main entrance follow the signs to the coach drop off and pick up point and the coach parking area (Note that car parking charges may apply).

Travelling by train

Let the train take the strain – the nearest station is Staines, which has a regular rail service from London Waterloo, Reading and Guildford. From just outside Staines station, the 950 THORPE PARK Express shuttle link runs to the park every half an hour.

Travelling by bus

You can get the local bus service to THORPE PARK from these three towns:

- Staines (from Stand 2 at Staines Bus Station) – take the 950, 951, 426, 446, 451, 461 or 551.
- Woking – take the 426 or the 446.
- Chertsey (from Heriot Road bus stop) – take the 451, 426, 461 or 446.

Arriving at THORPE PARK

With your pre-purchased group tickets, you can avoid the queues and go straight through the gates and into THORPE PARK... Please note that group tickets are not available on the day, so if you haven't pre-purchased tickets, sorry guys, you won't get a group discount.

If you've pre-booked but haven't received your tickets, speed things up and get them from the ticket vending machines to the left of the main queue at entrance to the Park (you'll need your booking confirmation number), then go straight on in.

Left luggage facilities

For obvious reasons, bags and loose articles are not allowed on the rides, so stow them away in the secure lockers at Guest Services. This is located in the lower level of The Dome, facing Depth Charge – you can't miss it!

Baby talk

If you haven't brought your own, you can hire baby buggies at Sweets and Souvenirs, located The Dome. It costs £6 for a single pushchair, £9 for a double, plus a £20 refundable deposit. Need to change a nappy? There are baby changing facilities conveniently located around THORPE PARK.
